Children to wear jeans or shorts, takkies and SAHETI t-shirt.

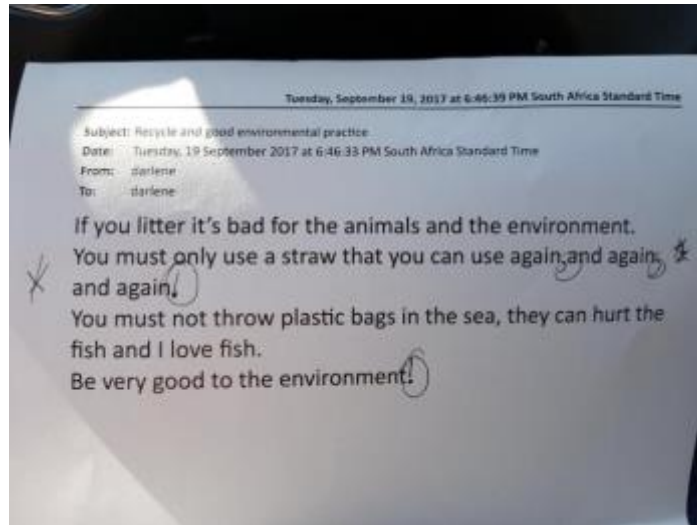
Hats are not required for this outing.
