



## POLICY

### Recognition of Primary School Pupil's Extra Curricular Achievements in Sporting and Cultural Activities not offered by SAHETI

SAHETI School recognises that pupils might achieve excellence in sporting and cultural activities not offered by the school. Recognition of excellence is an integral part of education. SAHETI will recognise any sporting or cultural activity not offered by the school in the following way:

- (1) Announcements of Achievement at School Assembly:  
The pupil will be called up and recognised achievement will be announced.
- (2) Announcement of Achievement in the SAHETI Newsletter and the School Communicator:  
The achievement will be publicised on the School Communicator and in the newsletter which is circulated to all parents and is placed on the SAHETI website (under 'newsletters').
- (3) Listing in the SAHETIAN (School Magazine):  
A list with pupil names who have Provincial Colours (not District Colours) in a sport will appear in the annual school magazine.  
e.g. Kahn, James Karate Northern Gauteng

#### Procedure:

The following procedure for the above to take place needs to be followed:

- (1) The parents need to forward details of the sport or cultural activity and the achievement received to the Vice-Principal of Student Affairs & Sport of the Primary School.
- (2) The information needs to be accompanied by the following supporting documents:
  - a. A signed declaration from the official Sports or Cultural Association or its representative on official letterhead of the relevant province.
